

Mrs. Math Elementary Placement Test Instructions

DISCLAIMER: Grade level expectations vary across programs and states. This placement test is designed to determine your child's level within the Mrs. Math curriculum.

General Instructions

- **Step 1:** Begin with the **Parent Survey** (First page of Part 1). Depending on the survey answers, your child will continue on to complete 1 or more parts of the assessment.
 - **Step 2:** Your child should complete the student assessments **independently** and **without a calculator**. Light supervision is encouraged to ensure no outside help is given.
 - **Note:** It's okay to **read questions aloud**, but **do not assist** in solving them. Encourage your child to use scratch paper and to try their best to answer each question. However, if they're completely unfamiliar with a topic, it's better to leave the question blank rather than guess.

Assessment Overview

There are **three parts** to the assessment. Your child may stop after Part 1 or 2, depending on their score.

Part 1: Elementary 2 & 3 Readiness

Scoring Guide:

- **0–10 points:** Start in **Elementary 2**. *No further testing needed.*
 - **11–14 points: Transition range.** Use your judgment. Consider your child's age, confidence, and prior experience.
 - Age 7 or below: Likely Elementary 2
 - Age 8 or above: Likely Elementary 3
No further testing required.
 - **15–18 points:** Continue to **Part 2**.

Part 2: Elementary 4 Readiness

Scoring Guide:

- **0–12 points:** Start in **Elementary 3**. No further testing needed.
 - **13–14 points: Transition range.**
 - Age 8 or below: Likely Elementary 3
 - Age 9 or above: Likely Elementary 4
No further testing required.
 - **15–18 points:** Continue to **Part 3**.

Part 3: Elementary 5 Readiness

Scoring Guide:

- **0–12 points:** Start in **Elementary 4**.
 - **13–15 points: Transition range.**
 - Age 9 or below: Likely Elementary 4
 - Age 10 or above: Likely Elementary 5
 - **16–20 points:** Ready for **Elementary 5**.
