

Mrs. Math Middle Grades Placement Test Instructions

DISCLAIMER: Grade level expectations vary across programs and states. This placement test is designed to determine your child's readiness/level within the Mrs. Math curriculum.

General Instructions

- Your child should complete the student assessment(s) **independently** and **without a calculator**. Light supervision is encouraged to ensure no outside help is given.
 - **Note:** It's okay to **read questions aloud**, but **do not assist** in solving them. Encourage your child to use scratch paper and to try their best to answer each question. However, if they're completely unfamiliar with a topic, it's better to leave the question blank rather than guess.
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Assessment Overview

There are **two parts** to the assessment. Your child may stop after Part 1, depending on their score.

Part 1: Math Foundations Readiness

25-Question Assessment

Scoring Guide:

- **0–14 points:** Start in **Elementary 5**. *No further testing needed.*
 - **15–17 points: Transition range.** Use your judgment. Consider your child's age, confidence, and prior experience.
 - Age 11 or below: Likely Elementary 5
 - Age 12 or above: Likely Math Foundations
No further testing required.
 - **18–25 points:** Your child is likely ready for **Math Foundations**. If you feel your child may be ready for Pre-Algebra, Continue to **Part 2**.
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Part 2: Pre-Algebra Readiness

Scoring Guide:

***assumes a score of 18 or more on Middle Grades Math Placement Guide (Part 1)**

- **0–12 points:** Start in **Math Foundations**.
- **13–15 points: Transition range.** Use your judgment. Consider your child's age, confidence, and prior experience.
 - Age 12 or below: Likely Math Foundations
 - Age 13 or above: Likely Pre-Algebra
- **16–20 points:** Your child is likely ready for **Pre-Algebra**.
